- 1. All articles in this class must be the handiwork of and owned by exhibitor. The word “display” refers in the first part to the quality and in the second part to quantity.
- 2. No person can receive a premium on more than one article in the same lot, and no article can be entered to compete in more than one lot.
- 3. Under the general head “Division” each kind must compete with its kind. Silk embroidery cannot compete with worsted embroidery, etc.
- 4. The committee is instructed not to award premiums unless the articles are deemed worthy of merit nor to articles borrowed or purchased for competition, nor those incorrectly named.
- 5. The management cannot be responsible for loss or breakage of exhibits.
- 6. Articles on exhibition cannot be removed until 5 p.m. on Sunday.
- 7. Articles known to have won premiums at a previous year’s Fair will be eliminated and held ineligible for prize awards.
